The church kitchen has received a 5\* rating from the food inspector, however he did point out the importance of making a record in the Kitchen Diary every time something is prepared in the kitchen. The diary is in the righthand draw under the water heater. If you are working in the kitchen please take time to read the food preparation rules in the diary too.

The other important point that he stressed is that those serving meals/refreshments in church need to be aware of any food allergens contained within the items coming into the church. We have now downloaded the relevant form, available in the drawer under the water heater or by emailing [info@catshillbaptist.org.uk](mailto:info@catshillbaptist.org.uk), that anyone making anything to be consumed in the church must complete.
