

Catshill Baptist Church Attendee Document



To all people intending to come to CBC for a service

We have done everything that we can to ensure that the building is 'Covid Secure' according to Government guidelines. If you would like a copy of our Risk Assessment (RA) then please contact us at office@catshillbaptist.org.uk.

As part of our RA, we have to inform you of a number of details that we ask you to observe before, during and after your visit. We ask for you to take the details listed below seriously, and to do your part in ensuring that we conduct our services in as safe a manner as possible.

As we are sure you are aware, these details can change at any time according to Government guidelines, and we therefore ask you to be aware of any potential updates before you attend CBC.

Before Attending

Please do not attend CBC if –

- You currently display any symptoms of Covid 19
 - A high temperature
 - A new, continuous cough
 - A loss or change in your sense of smell or taste
- You are currently isolating through testing, contact tracing or foreign travel
- You are clinically vulnerable or extremely clinically vulnerable

Please consider whether your attendance is necessary if you are aged 70+ as current Government guidance recommends that those 70+ look to minimize their contact with other households.

During Attending

We ask that you –

- Sanitise your hands immediately upon entering the building using sanitiser provided
- Leave you contact details with our Welcome Team, as part of Track and Trace procedures
- Wear a face mask during your time within the building
- Refrain from any physical contact with people from different household 'bubbles'
- Refrain from singing – note, currently there will be no 'live' music played
- Leave four empty seats between your household 'bubble' and another household 'bubble'
- Follow instructions on which toilets are in use, and wipe them down after use, including the door handles and flush handles, upon exiting
- Accompany children under 11 in your care, if they need to use the toilet
- Keep any children in your care within your seating area and not allow them to roam freely
- Bring your own drink if absolutely necessary, and do not use any of our kitchen facilities
- Bring your own Bible if you require one, and do not use any of the church's Bibles
- Do not offer First Aid to anyone outside of your household 'bubble', but inform the duty First Aider who will attend to the person whilst wearing PPE
- Leave the building immediately if you should feel unwell with Covid symptoms during a service, and inform someone from the Welcome Team as you leave

After Attending

We ask that you –

- Leave your seat to exit only when instructed to – to avoid all leaving at the same time
- Put any monetary offering, should you wish to give, into the indicated box in the foyer whilst exiting, taking care not to touch the box.
- Take any waste home with you
- Leave the building promptly, and do not mingle in the foyer to talk to others
- Do not gather in groups, apart from your own household bubble, immediately outside the church
